

Professional Guidance

Many professionals are involved when a SUDI occurs. The interactions between the different professionals and agencies have a bearing on the ongoing investigation and in particular the effect the experience has on the parents/ carers. Not all professions will be involved in every SUDI, but some disciplines such as child protection will be contacted routinely and may become involved if required.

This section allows users to access information and resources relating to all professions that may be involved with a SUDI.
